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A REVIEW ARTICLE OF SRUSHTI UTAPATTI WITH AYURVEDA AND MODERN ASPECT

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ABSTRACT

Human beings are always curiosity to explore reasonable analysis to know about origin and mysteries of universe throughout evolution. The universe is so vast in both space and time and was beyond the reach of our instruments and our minds. Man has achieved cosmic new heights today because of scientific revolutions. The colonization of Mars is the proposed process of establishing permanent human settlements on the planet Mars by astrophysicit. In Ayurveda perspective Sharira Rachana deals not only with 'constructive aspect of the human body but also with explores the fundamental nature of reality, existence and constructive entities like Avykta, Mahat, Ahmkara, Panchmahabhuta, Atma etc. In Hinduism, Brahma is Lord of the universe and their Maya who has created this multiform universe. Maya is wizardry power of Brahma that creates the cosmic illusion have no ultimate reality. While in Ayurveda The Prakṛti comes into contact with Purusha, the equilibrium of essential trigunas characteristics (Sattva, Rajas & Tamas) of Prakṛti is disturbed then unmanifest prakṛti comes along with consciousness purusha gives rise to manifest universe. Evolutionary biologists and modern scientists supported to Big Bang theory in the origin of universe. The Big Bang theory explains many phenomena including how the universe expanded from a very hot and dense state And how all matter in the universe came into existence at the same time, about 13.8 billion years ago.

INTRODUCTION

The universe, at present, is said to possess about 100 billion galaxies, each comprising an average of 100 billion stars. In comparison, Milky Way Galaxy is believed to possess 100 billion to 400 billion stars. [1] The origin of the Universe, the earth, the life, and the human socio-organization and all other important sections has evolved in an ascending manner. Science has confirmed that the universe have been developed over billions of years ago. There are stages in a human life: conception, birth, babyhood, childhood, puberty and adulthood. The life of the Universe can be similarly divided into stages, for it too was born and has grown up.

Literature reviews

Christianity, the *Bible* states that God created the universe in the beginning. In *Islam*, as supreme power Allah created the universe. As per *Bhagavad-Gita*, God is the source of all spiritual, intellectual, and material world. He is the beginning and the end. The cosmic universe is under his divine control. World is a product of the creative play of *Brahma'maya* (illusion). The life span of Lord *Brahma*, the creator, is 100 '*Brahma*-Years. One day in the life of *Brahma* is called a *Kalpa*, which is calculated to be 4.32 billion years. When 'night' falls, *Brahma* goes to sleep for a period of 4.32 billion years, which is a period of time equal one day (of *Brahma*) and the lives of fourteen *Manus*. The next 'morning', *Brahma* creates fourteen additional *Manus* in sequence just as he has done on the previous 'day. [2]

Srushti utpatti in Vedas & Upanishads: Vedas hold rich knowledge, regarding astronomy, physiology, medicine, mathematics etc., Rishi's explanations are reasonable and objective. Both the Rig Veda and Brahmanda Purana describe a universe that is cyclical or oscillating and

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infinite in time. The universe is described as a cosmic egg that cycles between expansion and total collapse. The universe, as a living entity, is bound to the perpetual cycle of birth, death, and rebirth. [3] *Kaivalya Upanishad* says that *Brahma* is the Creator of the Universe. *Chhaandoya Upanishad* is said that before creation the universe was existent. In another *Upnishad* mentions the word "*Sarvam khalu*" which means the whole universe is God, all other things are nothing but God. The great god transformed himself into multiform universe. They are the cause of the whole universe. [4] *Mandukya Upanishad*, stated that Universe is derived by *Brahma* As similar to a spider throws out and retracts its web, as herbs spring up in the ground. [5]

Srushti Utappti in Darsana Shastra: Vaisheshika darshana postulated theory of Paramanuvada (Atomic theory) .When Paramatma (God) has the interest to do Srishti Rachana(Origin of universe).- there were some actions AadiPrithvi noted in Asamkhya Paramanus(Atoms) combined to form larger molecules while Paramaanu do not do any action during Pralaya Kaala (Disappear of universe). [6] In Sankhya philosophy has described 25 tattvas (entities / principles) that are contributed to creation of universe (Srishti utpatti). These are – Avyakta, Mahat, Ahankara, Manas (Mind), 5 Jnaanendriyas (Sense faculties), 5 karmendriyas (Motor faculties), 5 Mahabhutas (Great elements), and 5 Tanmatras. When Prakruti (nature) and Purusha (Conciousness) come in contact with each other, then remaining elements begin appear to take gradually development to universe. Yogdarshana has too said the same concept of Sankhya Srushti utapatti. He has added one more *tattwa* – *Ishwara* (God).^[7]

Srushti Utappti in Ayurveda: The Origin of the universe is termed creation (Srishti or Sanga) and the Disappear called deluge or inundation (Laya or Pralaya). The material cause is the Prakiti which is the material used in the making of the universe. All ordered changes in material things depend for their occurrence on God and the soul. [8] According to the Acharya Sushrut, The whole universe is produced by Avayktha, which consists of components like Purusha and Prakriti. Acharya Charaka considered The concepts of creation and dissolution of the Universe is very similar with the Saamkhya concepts. He has said only 24 tattva as against Samkhya 25 tattvas. Purush and Prakriti as only one component hence explained as Chaturvimshatikatatva (24 principles). [9] In Ayurveda, The cycle of life and death has been said like the changing of Clothes from ones to the new ones by Purush/ Atma). Aatma (Soul) leaves the body at time of *Marana* (death) Enters into another body at time of *Janama* (birth) is based on the person's past deeds. (Karmaatmaka). [10] Ayurveda accepted various views of Indian philosophers to utilization their clinical application as well as understanding the various functions and creation of universe and in human. The Karya Karanavaada is actually based on Sankhyas philosophy where the cause is the essential prerequiste of

an effect. Satkaryavaad (Theory of Causation): The *Kaarya* is present in the *Karana* before it's manifestation, Postulated by-Saamkhya system. Paramanuvaad (Atomic Theory):- Postulated by the Vaisheshika philosophy. Paramanuvaada in Charaka Samhita: Paramanus are innumerable and very minute. Ayurveda is supported the theory of Paramanuvada for all creation of the gross universe and body organs under Karya-Karana Siddhanta (Cause and effect theory). [11] Avyakta is the root cause of all living being but it is causeless. According to Acharya Charaka, in the process of universe creation BuddhiTatva is produced by Avyakta. Ahamkara is produced by Buddhi but further this AhamkaraTatva produces Mahabhuta Mahabhuta give origin to Panchatanmatra and EkadashaIndriya. According to Sushrut Samhita, Parinamavada is one of the factor responsible for Uttapatti of Srushti, as it includes Swabhava, Ishwara, kala, Yadriccha, Niyati and Parinam, Acharya Sushrut opines that all effects of origin or development or existence of Srushti arises from pre-existing causes only.[13]

When Triguna goes back into equilibrium, Person achieve *Moksha*, that is, transcend death, the universe will go into dissolution (matter to energy). The *Prakriti* and *Purush* individually can not form the Universe. When these two are interconnected then only the universe can manifest.

The various steps of Srushti Utpatti (evolution of the universe) in Ayurveda: Avyakta: Avyakta Awastha of Prakriti is the equilibrium stage of Sattva, Raja and Tama. Where Prakriti in separate stage from Purusha. The Avyakta principle is the unmanifested form where universe in dissolution stage. Prakriti: It is the cause of all the creatures but it self it is causeless. Prakruti is the creative, primordial and active form that plays the main role in the creation of the Universe. *Purusha*: *Purusha* is absolute, pure consciousness and does not take an active part in the creation. It is only a witness or observer to the creation. In Upanishad Atman (Soul) is a part of Brahman. The Hindu philosophy's goal in human life is to reunite the atman with the Brahman (Parmatma). Purush depicted a lord of the universe. Mahat -This is the first primordial matter developed from Prakruti and Purusha. Ahankar- When Mahat attains ego, it gives rise to Ahankar. Ahankar is associated with separation and differentiation to gives Indriyas, Tanmatras and Mahabhutas. Indriya- By the combination of Aatva guna and Rajas guna, 5 sensory organs, 5 motor organs and mind, are developed. *Panchatanmatra* are derived by the combination of tamas and rajas guna. Panchtanmatra gives origin to *panchmahabhuta*. These are as follows: Akash Mahabhuta, Vayu Mahabhuta, Teja Mahabhuta, Jala Mahabhuta, Prithvi Mahabhuta. [14]

Modern View: Scientists N. Copernicus, G. Galilei, Kepler, I. Newton, Einstein, Stephen Hawking etc have created dispute to mythological ways of thinking with

origin of universe. A new Big Bang theory is developed to origin of universe (space, time and matter). The big bang theory is most accepted explanation for the origin of universe. The universe started as a singularity, a very dense and hot point. The singularity exploded, expanding space and cooling the universe. Subatomic particles merged to form atoms. Gravity pulled matter together to form stars and galaxies. Universe is a special manifestation of that energy. The energy produced during the conversion of its mass corresponded to the question proposed by Einstein: E=mc². in quantum mechanics on particles was another type of conversion that represented a micro-state conversion process. [15] The cosmos began 13.7 billion years ago with the big bang. A fraction of a second after the beginning, the universe was a hot, formless soup of the most elementary particles, quarks and leptons. As it expanded and cooled, layer on layer of structure developed: neutrons and protons, atomic nuclei, atoms, stars, galaxies, clusters of galaxies, and Finally super clusters. The theory states that the first organic compounds formed on Earth from carbon, hydrogen, water vapor, and ammonia. 
CONCLUSION
