



KHARJUR - A REVIEW FROM BRIHATTRAYI AND ITS THERAPEUTIC USE

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ABSTRACT

Kharjur (*Phoenix dactylifera* Linn.), commonly known as the date fruit, is a time-honored medicinal plant widely recognized in Ayurvedic literature for its nutritional and therapeutic benefits. Referenced across the *Bṛhatīrayī*—*Charaka Saṃhitā*, *Suśruta Saṃhitā*, and *Aṣṭāṅga Hṛdaya*—Kharjur is acclaimed for its *madhura rasa*, *śītavīrya*, and *balya* (strength-promoting) properties. This review article aims to consolidate the classical descriptions of Kharjur from these primary Ayurvedic texts, along with its pharmacological actions and therapeutic applications. In Ayurveda, Kharjur is primarily indicated in *kṣaya*, *raktapitta*, *trṣṇā*, *dāha*, and *kāsashvāsa*, owing to its nourishing and pitta-pacifying attributes. The article also examines modern pharmacological findings that support its traditional uses, including its roles as an energy booster, antioxidant, hepatoprotective, and anti-inflammatory agent. By bridging classical Ayurvedic knowledge with contemporary research, this review highlights the therapeutic relevance of Kharjur and advocates its potential inclusion in integrative healthcare approaches.

INTRODUCTION

Kharjur (*Phoenix dactylifera* Linn.), widely known as the date palm, holds a revered place in classical Ayurvedic literature for its potent nutritive and medicinal properties. Found abundantly in tropical and subtropical regions, its fruit is consumed both as food and medicine. In Ayurveda, *Kharjur* is classified under *Phala Varga* (group of fruits) and is described in detail in the triad of classical Ayurvedic texts collectively referred to as *Bṛhatīrayī*—namely, *Charaka Saṃhitā*, *Suśruta Saṃhitā*, and *Aṣṭāṅga Hṛdaya*. These texts emphasize its sweet taste (*madhura rasa*), cooling potency (*śītā vīrya*), and nourishing nature (*balya*).

DISCUSSION

In this literature review study, it is observed that Kharjur is an important aushadhiya dravya. It has been used for treating pittaj vikar, madatyata, jwar, shwas, kas, swarbhed, rajyashma, etc. Acharya Charaka has mentioned it in shramhar gana, phalasava and phalvarga along with 35 Ahar/Aushadhi Kalpana. Also it has pittashamak action due to Madhur rasa, Madhur vipak and shita virya. Thus it is useful in pitta pradhan conditions mentioned above.

Moreover, the integration of Kharjur into therapeutic regimens requires a standardized approach, including preparation methods, dosing guidelines, and identification of possible contraindications (e.g., in uncontrolled diabetes or certain metabolic syndromes).

CONCLUSION

With the help of above mentioned references and observationed, it is concluded that Kharjur is essential ahariya and aushadhiya dravya and not a vyadhi hetu of any disease. Kharjur, as described in the Br̥hattrayī,

exemplifies a perfect blend of nutrition and medicine. With its strong foundation in classical texts and increasing modern validation, it remains a valuable dravya in Ayurvedic practice.

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
