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## AYURVEDA PERSPECTIVE ON LEKHAN BASTI W.S.R. TO ROLE IN THE MANAGEMENT OF PCOD

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#### **ABSTRACT**

Acharya Sushruta mentioned Lekhana Basti as a form of Niruha Basti which possesses Shodhana & Lekhana properties. Lekhana means scraping or scratching, this property helps to eliminate morbid Doshas and Lekhniya Dravya removed increased Mala by their scraping action. The major ingredients of Lekhana Basti are Triphala Kwatha, Madhu, Gomutra and Yavakshara, etc. This therapy helps to treat many diseases including Poly Cystic Ovarian Disease (PCOD). Lekhana Basti provides remarkable responses in ovarian dysfunction and menstrual irregularities, etc. Lekhana Basti pacifies vitiated Vata and Kapha Doshas thus provides relief in the symptoms of PCOD. Lekhana Basti regularizes menstrual cycle, reduces body weight and control hormonal regulation therefore considered beneficial for PCOD.

### INTRODUCTION

Women in reproductive age are affected by many pathological conditions and polycystic ovarian disease (PCOD) is one of them, it is a prevalent cause of irregular and infrequent periods. Menstrual abnormalities, biochemical hyperandrogenism, and hyperinsulinemia are the hallmarks of this condition, which ultimately results infertility.

PCOD symptoms point to *Kapha* and *Vata Dushti* participation, which results *Avarodha* in *Artavavaha Srotas*. According to Ayurveda, this illness is related to the *Vata Dosha* (*Apan vata*) with symptoms of painful & irregular menstruation, underweight and feeling of cold sensation. *Pitta* predominance reveals symptoms of burning sensation, painful menses and clots. The *Kapha* predominance results hirsutism. Etiological factors like *Mithyachara*, menstrual disorders, ovarian factors, *Artava dushti* and *Beeja dosha*, etc. can trigger consequences of PCOD.

In the pathophysiology of PCOS, *Mithyachara* and already-existing *Artavadushti* play a significant role. This in turn cause a variety of *Yonivyapads* such as; *Jataghni, Vamini* and infertility. The primary function of the female genital tract is hampered by *Artava dushti*, which also causes additional complications like *Arsa*, *Asrigdara*, *Gulma* and *Vatapradhana daruna* disorders. PCOD mainly associated with hormonal imbalance and

menstrual disturbance which leads other complication including inappropriate weight and infertility, etc. [1-5]

#### **Treatment**

The goal of treatment is to remove restriction from the pelvis, restore normal metabolism, helps in cleansing and controlling menstruation, etc. The *Sodhana Chikitsa* (purification therapy) along with *Samana Chikitsa* (oral medication) play vital role in disease management. Since PCOD is regarded as a lifestyle disorder, a healthy diet and lifestyle adjustment were suggested to the patient. *Lekhana Basti* advises for PCOD under the category of *Sodhana Chikitsa* to relives symptoms of disease.

### Lekhana basti

Basti means administration of drug through anal route it is a types of Panchakrama procedure. The Bastis are of two types as depicted in Figure 1, in Asthapana basti or Niruha basti the decoction is the major part of therapy while in Anuvasana basti the oil or oleaginous substance used as major therapeutic component. Sharangdhara and Acharya Sushruta mentioned Lekhana Basti as a part of Niruha Basti in which decoction is used for scraping action. Triphala Kwatha, Madhu, Yavakshara and Gomutra, etc. are major components of Lekhana Basti.

#### Lekhan Basti in PCOD

The main treatment for *Vata* problem is *Basti Chikitsa* and *Lekhana Basti* is one of the treatments of *Vata* diseases. *Lekhana Basti* possesses *Lekhana, Pachana, Ushna* and *Tikshna* properties. It offers *Vatakapha Shamaka, Srotoshodhaka* and *Amapachana* actions. It operates on *Apana Vata* and normalizes its function. It lessens the buildup of *Medo Dhatu* which is associated factor of PCOD. *Lekhana Basti* lower LH level and normalize the FSH level to encourage the growth and development of follicles in PCOD patient. After entering Pakvashaya or Guda, Basti begins to work on the entire body. Guda is described as a Sharira Mula with Shiras and Dhamanies. It has both local and systemic effects. Apana Vata is normalized by Basti Dravyas and improves normal functioning of genital organs. As "Anila Anala Dharana" is one of the functions of Purisha, Basti corrects Agni Dushti and normalizes this activity. Basti normalizes Apana Vata function, resulting in normal Beeja Nirmana and Rajah Pravritti. The Basti provides Balya, Deepan, Pachan, Yonivishodhana, Artavajanana and Beejotsarga properties.

According to modern appraisal, any medication administered via the rectal route absorbed through the mucosal layer of the rectum and into the circulatory system. Since the enteric nervous system and central nervous system are similar, when Basti enters the gastro intestinal tract, it activates the enteric nervous system and produces stimulatory impulses for the central nervous system. These signals activate the gastroendogenous intestinal-tract's opioids, primarily endorphin, which limits the release of gonadotropinreleasing hormone. Thus Basti administered to PCOD patients modulates the Hypothalamic-Pituitary-Ovary axis, which normalizes both the ovarian cycle and the menstrual cycle. The function of Apana Vata may be caused by parasympathetic activity. The parasympathetic nerve supply may be stimulated by Basti, which in turn helps in follicle development and release of ovum.

#### Probable mode of action of drugs

The drugs used for *Lekhana Basti* offers *Amapachana*, *Srotoshodhana*, and *Vatakaphashamaka* qualities that may be the cause of their effectiveness in case of PCOD. *Ushna*, *Tikshna*, *Lekhana* and *Pachana*, etc., are characteristics of *Lekhana Basti's* contents that helps to

loosens toxins and helps in their expulsion. The *Vatanulomana* characteristic of *Basti* also supports this effect. The removal of *Sanga* facilitates by the *Kapha-Vata Shamaka*, *Srotoshodhana* and *Aama Pachana* qualities of medications. These properties also affect follicular growth and ovulation process. *Apana Vata* operates properly following the removal of *Sanga* caused by vitiated *Kapha* and *Ama* in *Artavavaha Srotas*, resulting normalization of *Rajah Pravritti* and *Beeja Nirmana*. The various *Guna* of *Basti Dravya* imparts different effects in PCOD as mentioned follows:

- The Sukshma Guna of Basti Dravya helps in reaching up to the micro channel of the body.
- ♣ Tikshana Guna helps to breaks down Mala and Dosha Sanghata.
- ♣ Snigdha Guna of Basti Dravya liquefies Doshas, that after they removes easily.
- ♣ The irritant property of Basti helps to eliminate vitiated Doshas.

The *Lekhana Basti* decreases LH level thus prevents premature lutinization, therefore growth and development of follicle stimulated by normal FSH level. *Lekhana*, *Rruksha*, *Tikshana*, *Deepana* and *Pachana* properties of drugs contributed towards the loss of body weight by controlling *Jatharagni*. As a result, it prevents accumulation of *Medodhatu* and ultimately causes *Lakshana Upashamana* of ailment. [8-10]

#### **CONCLUSION**

Basti helps to relives symptoms of PCOD, the Kwatha mainly Triphala decoction pacifies Vata and Kapha vitiation. Lekhan Basti regulates menstruation, decreases body weight, cause expansion of follicles and improves ovulation process. This therapy also helps to reduces premenstrual symptoms such as; hair loss and acne, etc. Lekhana Basti helps to treat Poly Cystic Ovarian Disease by improving ovarian dysfunction and menstrual irregularities, etc.

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
