The Shalakya Tantra is an Ayurvedic stream that addresses Urdhwajatru issues (body parts above the collarbone, such as the eye, ear, nose, and throat, among others). For therapeutic purposes, the branch mostly uses Shalaka Yantras, which devices are shaped like rods. Modern science indicates that there is a correlation between this stream and ophthalmology and E.N.T. Numerous Chikitsas are involved in Shalakya tantra, such as Karna-Chikitsa, Nethra-Chikitsa, Mukharoga-Chikitsa, Shiroroga-Chikitsa, and Nasa-Chikitsa, among others. Shalakya Tantra-related literature is covered by the Charak Samhita, Sushrut Samhita, and Ashtanga Hrudaya. According to contemporary science, this modality can be used to treat a variety of pathological conditions, including allergies, cataracts, glaucoma, conjunctivitis, ear infections, and nasal issues. The Shalakya Tantra, a traditional Ayurvedic text, describes surgical and para-surgical techniques for treating disorders of the ear, eyes, nose, throat, and other body parts. This article explained the Shalakya Tantra's general therapeutic methods in accordance with traditional Ayurveda.

An essential component of Ashtang Ayurveda, which addresses Uttamang Chikitsa, is the Shalakya Tantra. Some Shalakya Tantra techniques that aid in the treatment of diseases of the upper body parts include Varti, Anjana, Shirovirechana Karma, Karnapoorana, Padabhyanga Karmas, Akshitarpana, and Galganda, Upajihvika, Galashundi, Galgraha, Karnamoolika Shotha, Rohini, and Shankhak. Pratishyaya, Akshiroga, Ghrananasa, Ashabdashravana, Mukharoga, Karnaroga, Kanthodhwansa, Kashayashyata, Timira, Shiroruk, Vartmastambha, Galapaka, Mukhashrava, Shirahshoola, and Peenasha, among others.[1-5]

Tonsillitis, laryngitis, pharyngitis, mouth infections, bad breath, and dental caries can all be cured with *Kavalagraha* and *Gandoosha*.

Migraine and refractive headaches are treated with Shiropichu, Shirobasti, Shirodhara, etc.

According to current scientific research, diseases of the ear, eye, nose, and throat can be caused by a variety of etiological factors. These etiological factors include things like allergies, seasonal changes, microbial infections, water buildup in cavities, chemical injuries and side effects, etc.

Diseases like sinusitis, rhinitis, tonsillitis, chronic otitis, tinnitus, and laryngitis may be caused by these factors.

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Nasya Karma is a Panchakarma technique in which medication is administered via the nasal cavity to enhance drug delivery to the Shiras. Nasya aids in the treatment of conditions affecting the head, ears, throat, and nose. Dhumapana is effective in treating sinusitis and rhinorrhea.

Various *Netra Roga* can be treated by *Shalakya Tantra* approaches like *Puyalasa*, *Pakshmakopa*, *Adhimanta*, and *Abhisyanda*, among others. Drugs containing *Katu* and *Tikta Rasa* help to calm *Kapha*, which lessens *Netra Roga* symptoms like pain, itching, and watering of the eyes.

Laghu and Ruksha Gunas-containing drugs lessen eye pain and burning. Netra roga symptoms are alleviated by medications with anti-inflammatory, anti-spasmodic, and analgesic properties, such as Nayanamrita Lauha and Triphaladi Varti. Ayurvedic medications are useful in treating a variety of Netra Rogas, such as Sarvakshi, Timir, and Drishti Rogas. [5-8]

Shalakya Tantra elaborated on rhinoplasties and auraplasties as treatments for ear problems. Similar to this, other methods like Karnadhoopana, Karnaprakshaalana, and Karnapurana, among others, are also helpful in treating common ear conditions like tinnitus, mild deafness, wax buildup, ear infections, etc.^[8-10]
